



# WHAT TO EXPECT WHEN YOU TRAVEL.

Here are key changes in place or coming soon at Tampa International Airport.



## FACE MASKS

Required for all Airport employees in public areas; all travelers and guests are strongly encouraged to wear them.



## TSA CHECKPOINTS

Wider security lanes and larger recompose areas to maximize social distancing.



## PLASTIC SHIELDS

Plastic shields located in high-traffic areas: *ticketing counters, boarding gates, TSA security checkpoints, Customs and Border Protection checkpoints, shops, restaurants and other high-traffic spaces.*



## GROUND MARKINGS

Ground markings to encourage proper spacing.



## CLEANING

Even more frequent cleaning with the latest high-tech cleaning products, such as atomizers.



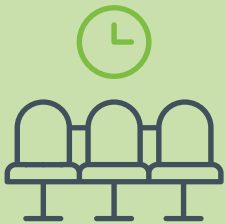
## HAND SANITIZERS

Hand sanitizing stations in high-touch areas, such as shuttle stops, TSA security and other high-volume areas.

## GATE AREAS

Some seats are blocked to allow more space for passengers.

*Airlines are encouraged to leave a gate empty between full flights, when possible, to minimize customer congestion.*



## TOUCH POINTS

Reduced touch points by encouraging more mobile boarding passes and carry-on luggage only.



## GIVE YOURSELF TIME

All guests are encouraged to arrive two hours before their flight to reduce overall congestion.



## MEETER-GREETERS

Only ticketed passengers are permitted in the terminal. Exceptions are made for those escorting unaccompanied minors or travelers in need of special assistance.
